Anderson Landfill is your one-stop shop for most of your recycling and disposal needs in Shasta and Tehama counties. The landfill is open to both residential and commercial customers. Located on 1,262 acres in Anderson, Calif., this WM facility is a Subtitle D Class III landfill that utilizes all the latest technologies to properly contain, recycle and manage materials brought to the location for disposal.

The landfill also includes a 100-acre wildlife preserve where WM works to enhance the habitat and safety of native plants, insects, and animals, including the Western Bluebird.

### SUSTAINABILITY AND ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION

WM is dedicated to creating a sustainable future. Operating landfills safely and with minimal environmental impacts is always our goal. Anderson Landfill serves as a perfect example of how WM utilizes the latest technologies to manage waste.

#### **Landfill Protections**

Anderson is engineered to protect the air, surface water and ground water. We have constructed a landfill that prevents any waste from coming into contact with native soil and prevents runoff from migrating into the ground. We also employ a robust gas well system and monitoring to capture methane gas before it seeps into the atmosphere.

# Wildlife Preserve

A 100-acre wildlife preserve on landfill property is protecting native species of plants and animals, including the Western Bluebird, a other species that has seen declines over that last decades. Anderson Landfill is in a prime Western Bluebird habitat and WM has worked to provide and enhance habitat on its property for the bird. Working with local schools, WM constructed and installed Western Bluebird nest boxes throughout the protected habitat which helped triple the number of sightings of Western Bluebirds in the habitat.

The habitat is also home to raptors, deer, jack rabbits, reptiles and bald eagles. The landfill is certified by the Wildlife Habitat Council, www. wildlifehc.org.
